Discovery process

When it comes to the process for utility service to new commercial properties, NV Energy is proud to offer its customers a discovery package. An applicant can request preliminary information regarding how the property will be served based on the applicants projected load. The Discovery Package will provide a map where the nearest electric line or gas main is located to serve their property and a ballpark cost estimate.

When the applicant is ready to start on construction, a completed application is submitted requesting electric and/or gas services. From there the required infrastructure is designed and installed, meters are set once an approval is received by the city/county building department, explains Jeff Brigger, NV Energy's Director of Business Development.

"A Discovery is a great resource for an applicant when doing due diligence on purchasing a property or starting the design process on a development," Brigger said. "The sooner the applicant talks to NV Energy regarding their project requirements, the sooner we can partner with the applicant to ensure smooth installations for their project."

Rate analysis and comparison

NV Energy will meet with businesses considering a move to Nevada and look at their current power bills and show them what that same bill would be in Nevada.

Renewable projects

Earlier this year, NV Energy announced the largest clean energy investment in Nevada's history when it announced 1,001 MW of renewable energy to be built in Nevada along with 100 MW of battery storage. In addition, in October we put out another request for proposal for an additional 350 MW (or more) of renewable energy. NV Energy currently ranks second in the nation in geothermal utilization and fourth in solar and is well on the way to meeting our goal of doubling our renewable energy by 2023. These projects will be added to NV Energy's current portfolio of 51 geothermal, solar, hydro, wind, biomass and supported rooftop solar projects.
